MULTI-SITE DATA USE AGREEMENT

The Publication and Dissemination Committee has reviewed your request for multi-site data for use in the development of an article and presentation for dissemination purposes. Your request is titled:

The Committee approved your request on January 7, 2003 and multi-site data will be made available to you for analysis as part of your article and presentation development. The data is the property of the University of Oklahoma and the Health Resources and Services Administration and may only be used for the topic you identified in your request. The data may not be made available to any other party without written consent from The University of Oklahoma and the Publications and Dissemination Committee.

Use of the data for Type III – Multi-site Data analysis is contingent upon timely development of the paper(s). If the lead author is unable to demonstrate substantial progress on the paper development by three months from the date of issue of the data, then the Publications and Dissemination Committee shall revoke the authorization for the use of the data. Papers must be completed within six months (paragraph extracted from *Statement of Understanding for the Publication and Dissemination of Multi-site Evaluation Findings*). Additionally, the lead author may use the data for presentations at regional, national, and international conferences as long as the presentation is consistent with the paper development topic.
