# Qualitative Study

- Key Informant Interviews with victims and perpetrators (20)
- Community Focus Groups (10 groups - 78 participants)
- Service Provider Interviews (32)

# Key Informant Interviews

- Identify service issues for victims and perpetrators
- Examine cultural factors that may contribute to IPV/SV or may ameliorate IPV/SV
- Identify barriers to accessing IPV/SV services or remaining in service

# Community Focus Groups

- Examine cultural values, attitudes, beliefs that may contribute to IPV/SV
- Community recommendations to addressing IPV/SV in Latino community
- Knowledge about existing services
- Identify barriers to services

# Service Provider Interviews

- Examine current access by Latinos
- Agency cultural competency
- Agency perceived barriers to access by Latinos
- Enhance collaboration between service providers and LCDA

# Current focus

- Content analysis of data to determine service needs of Latinos in regards to IPV/SV
- Development of a culturally appropriate IPV/SV intervention with recommendations from LCDA Linkage Council
